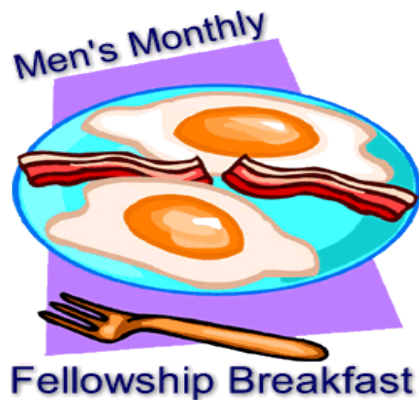

Background: Disciples Men at KCC have always enjoyed helping members with home repair projects

Intent: the men of KCC are eager to share their skills for small projects (2-4 hours) This help is not intended to replace the hiring of skilled craftsmen when appropriate.

Skills: work could include: lamp cord replacement, sink faucet replacement, sidewalk repair, hanging ceiling fans, unstopping commodes, repairing lawn sprinklers, caulking chimney flashing, and advising on options for major home repairs.

Procedure: requests should be made using the WORK REQUEST FORM (found at the Men's Ministry Center and on the web-site at www.kwcc.org) or given to Ryan Nelson-Paryag. A project committee will review the work, prepare an estimate (this may require a home visit) and try to respond within 72 hours. We will let you know if it is a project we can do, what the materials will cost and approximately when it can be done. There will always be at least two workers assigned to every job for safety reasons.

Cost: There will be no charge for labor. Materials are to be paid for by the home owner. Donations can be made to Disciples Men .
